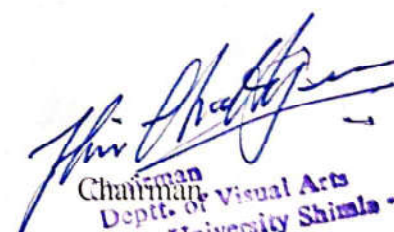

Extraneous variable

This is a variable that probably does influence the relationship between the independent and dependent variables, but it is one that we do not control or manipulate. For example, barometric pressure may effect pain thresholds in some clients but we do not know how this operates or how to control for it. Thus, we note that this variable might affect our results, and then ignore it. Often research studies do not find evidence to support the hypotheses because of unnoticed extraneous variables that influenced the results. Extraneous variables which influence the study in a negative manner are often called confounding variables.

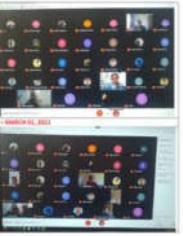
**Quality Control Biologist [QCB] Training Program 2019-2022 funded by DBT, GoI
conducted at Himachal Pradesh University, Summer Hill, Shimla-5 in
collaboration with LSSSDC and HIMCOSTE**

The Himachal Pradesh University (HPU), Shimla was sanctioned a DBT-GoI funded project of 3-years under 'Skill Vigyan Program' for Quality Control Biologist [QCB] being coordinated through Himachal Pradesh State Council for Science, Technology & Environment [HIMCOSTER]. This QCB program involved 3-months training of the selected candidates as per Course Curriculum of Life Sciences Sector Skill Development Council [LSSSDC] with compliance to National Occupational Standards [Qualification Pack]. The HPU has been one among the seven state institutions selected to run this program [with an intake of 25 candidates]. Each candidate during the training period was provided a scholarship/ studentship of Rs. 10,000/- month. The 1st batch of 20 candidates on merit basis were imparted training from March 01, 2021 to May 30, 2022 through both lectures as well as practical hands-on training (On-line) sessions. A total of 20 candidates initially conveyed their willingness to join the QCB training at HPU, Shimla. However, only 19 candidates [Ms. Poonam Sharma left the program] attended the on-line sessions/ classes. An Inaugural Session of the QCB training program was organized in an on-line mode on March 01, 2021 which was presided over by Prof. Arvind Kalia, Dean of Studies, HPU, Shimla along with the following panel of experts. The session was attended by professional from pharma/ food industry, research institute(s), faculty members of Department of Biotechnology, HPU, Shimla, Dr. Priyanka Sharma [HIMCOSTE representative] and the candidates enrolled in the training program. The QCB training sessions were started from March 02, 2021. The lectures were delivered through an on-line platform [Google meet] regularly by the following faculty/ experts;

- i. Dr. Ajay Tahlan, Director, Central Research Institute, Kasauli [HP].
- ii. Dr. S. S. Kanwar, Professor, Department of Biotechnology, HPU, Shimla-5.

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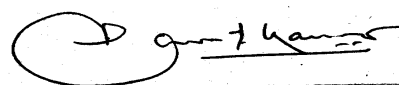
