5.4 **Eligibility:**

i) Candidates possessing a Bachelor's Degree (with the subject chosen for the Master's degree programme as major or minor or allied subject at the bachelor degree level) of HPU or any other University established by law in India or equivalent thereto are eligible for admission to the PG degree programmes (M.A., M.Sc. etc.)

ii) Minimum 50% marks (45% in case of those belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe categories) in the qualifying exam conducted by HPU.

iii) A minimum of 40% marks (35% for SC and ST) in the Entrance Test.

5.5 **Basis of Admission :**

The admission to these courses will be made strictly on the basis of marks obtained in the Entrance Test and shall be open to all, subject to the reservation approved by the University. The merit will be determined on the basis of competitive examination.

The minimum qualifying marks for the Entrance Test will be 40% (in case of SC/ST candidates, the minimum qualifying marks shall be reduced until the full SC/ST quota for admission has been exhausted) for calling the candidates for Interview/Admission.

Provided further that all seats in B.Ed. regular course shall be reserved for Bona fide candidate.

Admission against this reservation will be strictly on merit. If these seats remain unfilled they will be filled up in accordance with general practice as stated above. The practicing lawyers will be required to attend their classes regularly and those in employment will have to take leave for the duration of the course.

Provided further that the minimum eligibility for admission to a course in case of an outstanding sportsmen/woman will be 5% lower than the eligibility condition for other students except in case of MBA/MCA/MTA/LLB/LLM/DCA/B.Ed.

One supernumerary seat has been created to provide admission to Bonafide Himachali War Widows candidate in all courses of study on the campus except M.C.A., M.B.A., M.I.B.M., M.P.M., M.T.A., M.F.C., & M.Sc. (Bio-Technology) courses. The admission to these seats will be made on the basis of the entrance test.

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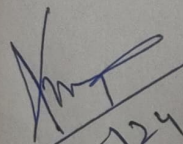

- The Candidate shall be required to pay the fee and other charges as per fee structure of this Institute up to the mentioned date (**Will be Notified Later**) failing which his/her right to **admission shall stand cancelled and the seat will be allotted to the candidate next in order of merit.**
Note: - For depositing the fee online it is compulsory that the name of depositor shall be that of the Candidate or the Father of the candidate. Once the fee has been deposited by the candidate in the **HPU: ONLINE PRE ADMISSION PORTAL**, he/she shall immediately inform the institute telephonically. Thereafter the Institute, after confirmation from the Bank, will inform the candidate about his/her admission in the Institute.
- The fee once deposited shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
- Last date of admission against the vacant/Vacated Seat (if any): (**Will be Notified Later**)

12 INTAKE AND RESERVATION CRITERIA

- 01 Out of total 120 seats 75 seats shall be the subsidised seats and the remaining 45 seats shall be the non-subsidised in accordance with the original format of the Institute as approved by HPU/BCI.
 - 02 Reservation Criterion shall be applicable in respect of 75 subsidised seats as per provision contained under the First Ordinances of Himachal Pradesh University and instructions/notifications issued from time to time by the University in the following manner:
 - (a) **15%** seats shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes of Himachal Pradesh.
 - (b) **7.5%** seats shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes of the State of Himachal Pradesh.
 - (c) **10%** seats shall be reserved for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates of Himachal Pradesh. However in case of non availability of EWS candidates the same shall be treated as Un-reserved (UR).
 - (d) The remaining **67.5%** seats shall be filled as under:-
 - (i) **25%** of seats shall be open to all the candidates irrespective of the institution from where they have passed their qualifying examination.
 - (ii) The remaining seats **75%** of the seats shall be filled out of the candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from Himachal Pradesh University or Himachal Pradesh krishi Vishvavidyalaya or Dr.Y.S.Parmar University of Horticulture and Forestry, Himachal Pradesh Technical University and Central University of Himachal Pradesh or the candidates who are Himachal Pradesh Domicile irrespective of passing qualifying examination from any other University established by law in India which is equivalent to the qualifying examinations of Himachal Pradesh University.
 - (iii) **5%** seats shall be reserved for person with disability of Himachal Pradesh with 40% disability to be certified by the competent authority.
 - (iv) **Two** seats shall be reserved for Single Girl Child candidate.
 - (v) **Two** seats shall be reserved for J&K Students.
 - 03 **Three** seats shall be reserved under non subsidized category for University Wards as notified vide Notification no.5-1/88- HPU (Genl)-Part-5 Dated 28th August, 2012.
- As per Judgement in CWP No. 1992/2017 and vide decision dated 12-01-2018 it has been decided by the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh, Shimla that for academic sessions necessary instructions be imparted to the effect that vacant reserved seats meant for SC and ST categories in educational institutes including schools, colleges and Universities, which remain unfilled after exhausting the list of available and eligible SC and ST candidates, should be thereafter offered and filled from amongst eligible candidates from open category on the basis of merit. We clarify that in case any cut off limit has been fixed, then only those candidates of open category should be admitted against the vacant seats, who have gained marks at par with the cut off limit.
